ADPP ANGOLA'S HEALTH PROGRAMS

- Total Control of the Epidemic (TCE) model implemented in collaboration with the Ministry of Health.
- Integrates community health into a holistic development model.
- Removes financial and travel barriers for underserved and high-risk populations.

2 MILLION PEOPLE REACHED BY TCE



► HIV/AIDS

ADPP Angola deploys community health workers to deliver HIV prevention, testing, and treatment adherence support in five provinces.

In 2025, ADPP supported:

- Over 1,000 Community Health Workers upskilled to deliver HIV and TB services
- 99% of pregnant women who tested positive for HIV initiate ART



► Tuberculosis

ADPP brings the full TB cascade directly into communities – breaking down the barriers to care.

In 2025, ADPP ensured:

- 53,790 people referred to clinics for TB diagnosis
- 7,852 new TB cases notified & 99% started on TB treatment
- 8,077 people at high risk of TB initiated on TB Preventive Treatment (TPT)

► Malaria

ADPP integrates malaria prevention into its broader community health strategy, including WASH and nutrition.

ADPP reached nearly 45,000 people with malaria information campaigns in 2025.
