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HPP-CONGO'S HEALTH PROGRAMS

- Total Control of the Epidemic (TCE) model implemented in collaboration with the Ministry of Health, mobilizes communities to take charge of their own health.
- Leverages trained community health workers (CHWS) to deliver life-saving, integrated HIV and TB services.

1.1 MILLION PEOPLE REACHED BY TCE SINCE 2006



► HIV/AIDS

HPP-Congo's TCE program in Kinshasa collaborates with private sector telecommunications companies to provide appointment reminders to clients receiving clinical services.

In 2025, HPP-Congo supported:

- 70 healthcare facilities across 6 health zones
- 132,697 people tested for HIV
- 25,000 people living with HIV receiving life-saving ART



► Tuberculosis

HPP-Congo's deploys Field Officers to supervise CHWs delivering community-led TB services and treatment adherence support.

From January to June, 2026 HPP-Congo

- Screened and identified over 5,000 people presumptive for TB
- Diagnosed and notified over 900 people with TB
- 18% positivity rate, higher than the national average of 10%

► Malaria

HPP-Congo combines awareness campaigns with targeted interventions to combat disease transmission at the community level. HPP-Congo conducted 893,000 tests and treated 532,000 cases in 2024.
