HPPI'S HEALTH PROGRAMS

- Implemented in collaboration with State AIDS Control Societies, the Ministry of Health and Welfare, and the National TB Elimination Programme, mobilize communities to take charge of their own health.
- Targets populations most at risk to bridge national health systems with community-based care.

► HIV/AIDS

HPPI collaborates with the State AIDS Control Societies under the National AIDS Control Programme to provide quality-assured STI/HIV intervention services to vulnerable populations.

In 2024/2025, HPPI ensured:

- 47,253 people in urban areas participated in health camps
- 11,835 women active in Women's Health Clubs



► Tuberculosis

HPPI's TB programs bring mobile screening and chest x-ray to vulnerable communities - homeless people, mobile and migratory populations, and slum dwellers.

Across 4 major cities, Project LEAD (2023-2024):

- reached 609,102 people with prevention and treatment services
- identified 3,186 positive TB cases
- maintained treatment initiation rates above 96%



► Non-Communicable Diseases

HPPI conducts awareness drives, early screening, detection, and linkage to treatment for diabetes, hypertension, mental health, and breast and cervical cancer.

HPPI incorporates economic support with women's health access.
